# **Starting and Finishing school**

In the morning we start school at 8:40am and enter the classroom through our own class door.

We need to come to school prepared for the day. We must have our breakfast and put on our school uniform. We need to bring our school bookbag (not a rucksack), our coat and a full water bottle every day.





When it is our home time, we get our bookbags, coats and water bottles then wait to be collected from the classroom door.

Our teacher will call our names when they see our parent or carer and then we can get up and leave.

We need to bring a bookbag, a coat and a water bottle to school every day.

We put our water bottles in the water bottle tray as we enter the classroom.





Next, we put our bookbags into our class drawers. These have our picture and names on.



After that we hang our coats on named pegs. Finally, we find our picture and put it on our 'Feelings Board'. We can visit the wall during the day to move our picture if our mood changes.

We have our own toilets which we can use throughout the day and wash our hands before lunch and snack time



#### **School Uniform**

We wear a white polo shirt, navy school cardigan with a navy school jumper or cardigan.

We can wear grey school trousers, shorts or skirts.

In the summer months we can wear summer dresses.

Parents and carers can buy these from our uniform supplier. They can also buy trousers, skirts and shorts in other shops.

On our feet we need to wear black school shoes, not trainers.



### **Independent Learning and Lunchtime**

If we are staying at Nursery all day we have to bring a packed lunch in a named lunch box. We eat our packed lunch in our classroom. Our teachers are there to show us how to open difficult containers and to clear away after we have finished.

Then we go out to play. There are School Meal Supervisory Assistants (SMSAs) to help us when we play in our playground.

We can choose to do our 'Independent Learning' inside or outside.





We have lessons with the teacher every day. These focus on one of the seven areas of development.

These are: Personal Social Emotional Development, Physical Development, Communication and Language, Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding the World and Expressive Arts.

We also have a Phase One Phonics Letter and Sounds lesson every day and a music lesson once a week with the school Music Teacher.

We like to share our learning in many creative ways, role play, model making and creative arts.







# **Collective Worship**





We have collective worship in our classroom with our peers.

Each term we focus on one of the Christian values. Our collective worship will help us understand these values.

Each week we will have a Religious Education lesson.

We say the school prayer together every day.
